"Since the golf courses began construction we've had bad sediment flow with every rise in the river. When the water drops any low areas have 1-2 inches on average of a black nasty sediment that we've also never had before. The beaches that used to be white when the water drops are now black after each drop as well." Local resident

Background sample taken upstream at the overpass on SR-70 between Singletary and MJ Rds read 2.39 NTUs*.




*Turbidity of any water that leaves the site and impacts the water systems cannot be higher than 29 NTUs above background.

806 and 778 NTU readings taken on 8/30








Community Water Quality Testing Program:

- Training and oversight by Dr. Abbey Tyrna, Suncoast Waterkeepers.
- Weekly testing since January 22, 2025: Water quality data (tubidity) as well as related visual observations (odor, water color, algae presence).
- Measurements below the golf course developments as well as background measurements are being collected.



"The minnow population is extremely low compared to what it used to be and there is more silt in the river than I have ever seen in my lifetime of being here. Normally the bottom is clean and sandy this time of year and there is a solid layer of vegetative silt covering the bottom of the river...there's a layer of sediment over the sand that did not exist previous to this construction".

The deeper holes always have had a sediment layer but there is so much sediment now that it is throughout the entire River. Usually in the winter time and all throughout the spring the river would be extremely clean looking. Which is not the case now. It's hard to convey that to people who are seeing it for the first time..."

Construction in area has had a history of discharges, multiple residents are now newly complaining about the water quality in Myakka river, reporting sediment deposits that are not historically present and murky waters. DEP is currently pursuing enforcement for the CGP MiaKKa Golf (SWFWMD Permit 43046811) over poor BMP management and turbid discharges.

<u>A second ERP</u> application from Miakka Golf Club, which will result in additional wetlands impact, was recently approved by SWFWMD.

Wetland mitigation for permanent impacts will be provided by the purchase of 1.42 non-forested wetland credits from the Myakka Mitigation Bank - ERP No. 43003997.000.

While the second permit was under review, I reached out to the SWFWMD Environmental Scientist assigned to the Environmental Resource Permit to express concerns and asked whether a SWFWMD assessment to quantify the increase in silt depots and their composition is in order, given both the resident complaints and DEP reports.

A SWFWMD compliance inspector conducted a site visit in response to the DEP inter-agency complaint. His visual inspection did not detect any irregularities in the river or BMPs. A more thorough assessment was not deemed warranted.

Short Form Consent Order issued to Miakka Golf Club, to levy \$6,500 in fines for the discharges found during DEP's inspection days in August and September, 2024. The developer has paid the fine and the case is now closed.

Mr. Wilson:

The State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") finds that David Wilson ("Respondent" or "you") failed to conduct inspections per the construction generic permit, maintain records per the construction generic permit, develop an adequate stormwater pollution prevention plan, and properly install/implement/operate/maintain best management practices in violation of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Chapter 62-621, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Before sending this letter, the Department requested that you undertake certain actions to resolve the violation(s). These actions have since been completed. However, due to the nature of the violation(s), you remain subject to civil penalties. You are also responsible for costs incurred by the Department during the investigation of this matter.

The Department's Offer

Based on the violations described above, the Department is seeking \$6,000 in civil penalties and \$500 for costs and expenses the Department has incurred in investigating this matter, which amounts to a total of \$6,500. The civil penalties are apportioned as follows: \$6,000 for the violation of F.A.C. 403.121(4)(b).

- (3) acknowledge that payment of the above amount does not constitute a waiver of the Department's right, if any, to recover emergency response related costs and expenses for this matter.

The Department acknowledges that your acceptance of this offer does not constitute an admission of liability for the violation(s) referenced above.

Respondent's Performance

After signing and returning this document to the Department,

- (1) You must pay \$ 6,500 in full by April 18, 2025.
- (2) Respondent shall make all payments required by this Order by cashier's check, money order or on-line payment. Cashier's check or money order shall be made payable to the "Department of Environmental Protection" and shall include both the OGC number assigned to this Order and the notation "Water Quality Assurance Trust Fund." Online payments by e-check can be made by going to the DEP Business Portal at http://www.fldepportal.com/go/pay/.

It will take a number of days after this order is final, effective and filed with the Clerk of the Department before ability to make online payment is available.

The Department may enforce the terms of this document, once final, and seek to collect monies owed pursuant to Sections 120.69 and 403.121, F.S.
